Different construction sites demand different lifting solutions. Our experienced team can help you choose the best crane for your job.



## Luffing jib cranes

### Ideal for tall structures:

Work efficiently with the jib raised, reducing the mast height needed to clear the building.

### Great for city sites:

Short out-of-service radius prevents oversailing and keeps operations compliant on confined urban plots.

### Optimised for tight sites:

Operate safely and effectively alongside multiple cranes in close proximity.

### Maximum productivity:

Luffers can be positioned close together to increase 'hook time' and handle high volumes of lifts.

### Space-saving design:

Hydraulic models park with the jib at a steep angle, minimising footprint when not in use.



## Saddle jib cranes

### Versatile:

Available in a wide range of heights and jib configurations, making them ideal for most building projects.

### Flexible setup options:

Choose from ballasted, fixing-angle, or rail-travelling bases to suit your site requirements.

### Cost-effective lifting:

Significantly cheaper to hire than mobile cranes, making them the smart choice for sites without oversailing constraints.

### Energy efficient:

Lower power requirements for hoist and slew motors mean reduced running costs, whether using mains power or generators.

### Compact and economical footprint:

Low base loadings require minimal space and lower foundation costs compared to other crane types.



## Remotely-operated cranes

### Team efficiency:

On low-intensity sites, a trained Slinger/Signaller can also operate the crane, this combines banksman and operator duties. This allows one person to handle both roles, staying productive between lifts.

### Flexible control:

Smaller saddle jib cranes can be operated from the cab or pedestrian-controlled for maximum convenience.

### Space-saving remote operation:

Remotely-operated top-slewing cranes require far less space at ground level than self-erectors, especially during erection and dismantling, which typically need 15-18m to unfold and re-fold.

# Planning your next build?

## Step 1

### Provide detailed building measurements

This includes the exact height of each building on site and design notes – e.g. sloped roofs

#### Why it matters

Crane height has a big impact on cost

## Step 3

### Specify what you're lifting

Include details about materials, maximum weights, and the number of heavy lifts

#### Why it matters

Accurate specs allow us to match the right crane to the job

## Step 5

### Confirm the number of lifts per day

An estimate of how many lifts are needed each day helps us to size the crane for speed and workload

#### Why it matters

Underpowered cranes can lead to costly bottlenecks

## Step 2

### Provide detailed site plan drawings

Include the location of your materials store as this has a significant impact on crane positioning

#### Why it matters

The wrong crane location can limit productivity

## Step 4

### Be realistic about timescales

Include start and end dates, as well as phases. Keep potential disruptions in mind, such as bad weather conditions

#### Why it matters

Underestimated durations lead to unexpected hire costs

## Step 6

### Confirm who will supply lifting team

Do you need crane operators and slinger/singaller, or will you supply your own lifting team?

#### Why it matters

An experienced lifting team will maximise safety and efficiency
